### Requirements

- Degree in Physical Education, Sports Science, or recognized Football degree.
- Be able to communicate effectively within a team.
- Be a positive, kind, and caring person.
- Good behaviour management skills
- Prior experience in specific field

### Role Description

You may find below the description of the role. The details are not to be construed as exclusive or all-inclusive.

The provision by the Head Coach of football lessons to the school's students and of coaching services to the school are the following:

- Consistently teaching at a high level to ensure pupils' learning is challenging and progressing.
- Assessing, recording, and reporting on the development, progress, and attainment of pupils.
- Checking on the athletic progress of individual pupils on a regular basis.
- Conferences with parents/guardians, as necessary, regarding the athletic performance of their student.
- Follows state, regional, and district regulations governing the athletic program.
- Models' sportsman-like behavior and maintains appropriate conduct towards players, officials, and spectators.
- Ensuring that all records and data collection are kept up to date and that information is passed onto Director of Sports in a timely manner.
- Communicating and consulting with the parents or carers of pupils about their child's progress in all areas
- Follows established procedures in the event of an athlete's injury.
- Communicating and co-operating with agencies outside the school as appropriate.
- Working as part of a team to plan collaborative learning plans for athletes in their particular year group.
- To select in collaboration with the Director of Sports the football players participating in the sports School.

- To monitor the football players' progress and complete progress reports accordingly.
- To provide feedback to participating students in the Sports School and their parents during Academic Review Days/Feedback Days.
- To coach the students, strictly only during the agreed hours and days (Monday to Thursdays from 07:30-09:00, holidays not included) or oversee their coaching sessions held by the Substitute.
- To support with his knowledge, the organisation of school football tournaments and football competitions at the school.
- To liaise with the Director of Sports whenever there is a tournament or competition outside of school to decide who is going to accompany the students.
- Providing guidance and advice to pupils on their social and emotional development
- Maintaining high standards of behaviour in all learning situations: being aware of the School's Behavioural Policy and procedures
- Maintaining a high standard of pupil behaviour in the playground and common areas, being alert and proactive and inform and liaise with Director of Sports when appropriate.
