Job Description

Position: Summer School Camp Team

Purpose of this post

The **Summer School Team** is responsible for implementing summer school programs (including but not limited to activities, beverage arrangements, safeguarding of kids etc.) to support both enrichment and remedial learning for students. We aim to give students an educational, culturally enriching and memorable summer experience in a safe and supervised setting

Duties & Responsibilities

Summer School ethos

- Be punctual, arrive at school on time
- Be kind, understanding and compassionate with children
- Share ideas, be collaborative
- Engage in activities with the children
- Be mindful and respectful of resources, working space and colleagues
- Act as a positive role model and leader always
- Be flexible, adaptable, enthusiastic and a team player
- · Participate in staff meetings as requested

Health and Safety

- Ensure children are always safe, follow the health and safety policy as well as safeguarding.
- Have good communication and coordination with the nurse and camp leader
- Ensure that assigned groups of children are always supervised
- Be vigilant and report any unsafe environment or hazards
- Ensure pick up card is presented before dismissing children
- Ensure to record any accidents or incidents in the logbook and fill in all information Requested
- Be aware of any allergies or children's special needs

Day-to-day responsibilities

- Set standards and norms of good practice and deal with any problems swiftly, fairly and appropriately. Inform camp leader immediately of anything that occurs.
- Be reliable and able to build good relationships with the children.
- Set up activities, maintain equipment and be organized.
- Collect all items left behind in the lost and found area assigned.
- Ensure camping site is clean and that campers don't litter recreational areas or nature.
