Job Description

Position: After School Club – Supervisor

Line Manager: Enrichment Coordinator

General

The After School Club – Supervisor is responsible for overseeing the well-being, safety, and development of children. This role involves ensuring a positive and nurturing atmosphere conducive to learning and growth.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Supervise and monitor children from ages 3 – 11
- Follow safeguarding rules and ensure the safety of all children in all times
- Supervise children and ensure their safety, development, growth, skill achievement, and general well-being
- Develop and implement behaviour management strategies to create a positive and respectful learning environment
- Address and resolve behavioural issues with children in a constructive and consistent manner
- Interact and engage the students with their academic studies and homework (Y1 onwards).
- Keep children busy by following a well-structured program of different activities
- Support and help students with a range of abilities
- Mediate any children’s disputes
- Report any incidents that occur swiftly to the head of Supervision
